PRICES

On-Site Workshops

£150 for one workshop over a half-day, led by one artist.

£250 for two workshops over a full day, led by one artist*.

£450 for four workshops over a full day, led by two artists.

In-School Workshops

£150 per class per half day.

*We can work with a maximum of 60 students on one day which will be split between two 30-student workshops. Whilst one group works with the artist, the other group will have a teacher-led session.

Prices include a space to eat lunch, and all workshop materials. Our workshops are inclusive, ensuring that all children actively participate and achieve. We can work with a maximum of 30 students per workshop.

VISUAL ARTS WORKSHOPS

Taking inspiration from our beautiful surroundings and exciting exhibitions, these workshops enhance visual creative learning for all key stages. All workshops can be delivered on site or in school, and each is moulded to fit with the current exhibition or topic of the time. Visual arts workshops last 2 hours each.

EYFS/ KS1

Exploring Colour

A playful exploration of colour looking at questions such as How does colour make you feel? How does colour change and transform?

Shape/Space

Using our bodies, explore our understanding of the shapes and space around us to create a group sculpture, before using different materials to create an artwork.

Drawing

Use Lakeside's huge array of different materials to improve confidence in drawing.

KS2

Developing Colour

Learn about colour theory and painting techniques by studying how artists use light and colour and then having a go yourself!

Shape and Form

Transform 2D drawings into 3D forms and sculptures using Lakeside's exciting range of different materials.

Drawing and Mark Making

Explore mark-making with a huge range of materials and make drawings with new media.

Materials and Media

Experiment with familiar and unusual materials to learn about traditional and non-traditional processes.

Adorning Nature

Take part in a half-day workshop in response to our outdoor public artwork, Eurydice Prevails. Learn about the artist Elpida Hadzi-Vasileva and then, using found materials from around the park, create your own sculpture, reflecting the patterns we see in nature.

TRADITIONAL TALES DRAMA WORKSHOP

Our workshops empower children from EYFS to KS2 to explore popular books, traditional tales and fairytales first-hand, by embodying the characters and reimagining the story's world.

A Traditional Tales drama workshop is an exciting way to engage young learners and bring these timeless stories to life.

Exploration of Key Stories: Children will delve into classic tales like Little Red Riding Hood, Jack and the Beanstalk, and The Three Little Pigs. These stories can be adapted to suit your class's needs and curriculum.

Understanding Common Settings: Through drama, students will grasp the common settings found in traditional tales. They'll explore enchanted forests, magical castles, and other captivating backdrops.

Sequencing and Narrative Elements: Drama helps children understand story structure, including the beginning, middle, and end. They'll learn how to sequence events effectively.

Character Challenges and Solutions: Pupils will step into the shoes of characters facing challenges. They'll explore how these characters overcome obstacles, fostering empathy and critical thinking.

Moral Lessons: Traditional tales often carry valuable life lessons. Drama provides a dynamic way to explore these morals and discuss their relevance.

We can tailor our workshops to cover the books or topic you are working on in school as well as having pre-set workshops for a range of popular books.
