I am waiting/sitting on this bench for you now and I can see children playing. I can see boats on the lake, seagulls landing and ducks paddling. I can see the ice cream van. I can see bicycles. I can see families. I can see insects. I can see people walking past on their mobile phone. I can see the gallery, the theatre, the pavilion, the boat house. I can see life buoys to be thrown into the water in case of an emergency. I can see a statue of the man who built this. I can see winged eagles/angels on gate posts. I can see a path. I can see a croquet lawn. I can see a bowling green. I can see an island. I can see railings. I can see a balcony with graffiti on it.

I can see benches with plaques on them. I can see trees that are symmetrical but grown out of shape. I can see leaves falling. I can see pushchairs and people in masks, people social distancing and people taking selfies with the water behind them. I can see traffic. I can see trams. I can see aeroplanes. I can see a pylon.
